## The Banking Act 1979 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1985

Made - - - 21st May 1985

The Treasury in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 52(3) of the Banking Act 1979(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Banking Act 1979 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1985.

2. The provisions of the Banking Act 1979 specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on 1st July 1985.
