**The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment)
Regulations 1985**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	30th May 1985
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	7th June 1985
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st July 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 119, 120(1) and 124 of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1985.

2. The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977(c) shall be further amended as follows.

3. For Regulation 8 substitute the following Regulation:—

"Fees for licences

8. The fee for the grant of a provisional licence is £3 and the fee for the grant of a full licence is £7.50".

4. In Regulation 14 (Lost, defaced and exchanged licences)—

- (1) in paragraph (1) for "£1.25" substitute "£1.50"; and
- (2) in paragraph (3) for "£1.25" substitute "£1.50".

5. Nothing in Regulations 3 and 4 of these Regulations shall apply where an application for a licence (full, provisional, duplicate or exchange) was received before 1st July 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977 by increasing the fees for licences.

The fee for a provisional licence is increased from £2.50 to £3, the fee for a full licence is increased from £5.50 to £7.50 and the fee for a duplicate or exchange licence is increased from £1.25 to £1.50. These increases apply where an application is received on or after 1st July 1985.
