The Mid Kent Water Order 1985

Made - - - - - 28th January 1985

Coming into Operation 29th January 1985

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 23 and 50 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Mid Kent Water Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 29th January 1985.

(2) The Mid Kent Water Acts and Orders 1888 to 1976 and this order may be cited together as the Mid Kent Water Acts and Orders 1888 to 1985.

Interpretation

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Company” means the Mid Kent Water Company;

“the Order of 1973” means the Mid Kent Water Order 1973(c);

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

Additional capital and borrowing powers

3. As from the commencement of this order:—

(a) section 4 (Capital and borrowing powers) of the Order of 1973 shall have effect as if:—

(i) in subsection (1), for the words “thirty-two million pounds” there were substituted the words “fifty million pounds”;

(ii) in paragraph (i) of the proviso to subsection (1) immediately before the words “the amount” there were inserted the words “three times”;

(iii) in paragraph (ii) of the proviso to subsection (1), for the words “five per cent.” there were substituted the words “ten per cent.”;

- (iv) in subsection (8), for the reference to the coming into operation of the Order of 1973 there were substituted a reference to the coming into operation of this order; and
- (b) section 6 (Maximum rates of dividend) of the Order of 1973 shall have effect as if for the references to the Order of 1973 and to the commencement of that order there were substituted references to this order and to the commencement of this order.

Application of section 94 of Third Schedule to Water Act 1945

4. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which requires undertakers to keep a copy of the special Act at their principal office, and to deposit copies with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order.
