**1986 No. 1021****PETROLEUM****The Petroleum (Production) (Amendment) Regulations 1986***Made* - - - 18th June 1986*Laid before Parliament* 19th June 1986*Coming into Operation* 11th July 1986

The Secretary of State in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Petroleum (Production) Act 1934(a), and now vested in him (b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 11th July 1986 and may be cited as the Petroleum (Production) (Amendment) Regulations 1986.

2. The Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1982 (c) shall have effect subject to the following amendments:—

- (a) in paragraphs (1) and (2) of Regulation 11, as amended (d), for the word “£2,200” there shall be substituted the word “£2,500”;
- (b) in Part V of Schedule 3, after the word “crossed” there shall be inserted the words “not negotiable A/C Payee only”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1982 which relate to the making of applications for, and the model clauses to be incorporated in, petroleum licences.

The Regulations provide for an increase in the fee payable by applicants for production licences in seaward areas, and specify how cheques which accompany applications are to be crossed.
