ROAD TRAFFIC

The Crown Roads (Royal Parks) (Application of Road Traffic Enactments) (Amendment) Order 1986*Made* - - - 14th July 1986*Laid before Parliament* 21st July 1986*Coming into Operation* 12th August 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 131 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Environment as the appropriate Crown authority for the Crown roads to which this Order relates, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Crown Roads (Royal Parks) (Application of Road Traffic Enactments) (Amendment) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 12th August 1986.

2. For article 5 of the Crown Roads (Royal Parks) (Application of Road Traffic Enactments) Order 1977(b) there shall be substituted the following article —

“5. The Secretary of State hereby directs that sections 104, 105 and 106 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 shall apply to the Crown roads in the Royal Parks known as Hyde Park, Kensington Gardens, Regent’s Park, Saint James’ Park and The Green Park in Greater London as they apply in relation to other roads to which the public has access.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Crown Roads (Royal Parks) (Application of Road Traffic Enactments) Order 1977 by applying sections 104–106 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (immobilisation of vehicles illegally parked) to Crown roads in Regent's Park. The amendment also updates the relevant statutory references.
