The Road Traffic (Temporary Provisions as to Fixed Penalties) Order 1986

Made - - 29th July 1986

In exercise of the power conferred upon me by paragraph 1 of Schedule 12 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Temporary Provisions as to Fixed Penalties) Order 1986.
 - (2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.
- 2. The date appointed as the date on which the repeal of section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(b) by the Transport Act 1982(c) would have been brought into operation had section 80 not already been repealed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is 1st October 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings to an end on 1st October 1986 in England and Wales the "interim period" referred to in Schedule 12 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (temporary provisions as to fixed penalties). That Act repealed, but in Schedule 12 temporarily re-enacted, the fixed penalty provisions of section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 pending their replacement on 1st October 1986 by the extended fixed penalty provisions of Part III of the Transport Act 1982 (S.I. 1986/1326).
