CONTAMINATION OF FOOD

The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales)
Amendment No. 3 Order 1986

Whereas the Secretary of State is of the opinion, in accordance with section 1(1)(a) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985(a), that there has been or may have been an escape of substances of such descriptions and in such quantities and such circumstances as are likely to create a hazard to human health through human consumption of food;

And whereas the Secretary of State is of the opinion, in accordance with section 1(1)(b) of the said Act, that in consequence of the said escape of substances food which is or may be in the future in the area described in the Schedule to the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986(b), or which is derived or may be in the future derived from anything in that area, is, or may be, or may become, unsuitable for human consumption;

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the said section 1(1) and 24(3) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Amendment No. 3 Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 5th September 1986.

Partial revocation and amendment

2. The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986 is revoked to the extent that it imposes prohibitions in respect of sheep which are in the area described in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 as set out in the Schedule to

this order on 5th September 1986; and accordingly that order is further amended in accordance with the following provisions of this order.

3. After article 7 there shall be inserted the following article—

“8. Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this order shall not apply in the case of any sheep which was in that part of the designated area described in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to this order on 5th September 1986.”.

4. For Schedule 2 there shall be substituted Schedule 2 as set out in the Schedule to this order.

AREA EXCEPTED FROM ARTICLES 4, 5 AND 6

Area excepted from restrictions on 29th August 1986

1. An area comprising those parts of the designated area which lie within the following boundaries:—

(1) From the junction of the A548 road with the B5113 road at OS map ref SH 830638 generally eastwards along the A548 road to its junction with the B5384 road and then along the B5384 road to its junction with the unmarked road at Gwytherin at OS map ref SH 877616 and then generally south-westwards along the unmarked road to its crossing with the Afan Derfyn at OS map ref SH 858599 then generally northwards along the course of the Afan Derfyn to its crossing with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 853624 then generally south-westwards along the unmarked road to its junction at Gors Wen at OS map ref SH 837621 and then generally northwards along the B5113 road to its junction with the A548 road at OS map ref SH 830638.

(2) From the junction of the A543 road with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 929568; generally north-eastwards along the A543 road to its junction with the B5401 road at Llyn Bran; southwards along the B5401 road west of Llyn Brenig to its crossing with Afon Alwen at OS map ref SH 963523 then generally north-westwards along the course of the Afon Alwen to the Alwen Reservoir to where it meets with the Afon Alwen and then along the course of the Afon Alwen to its crossing with the A543 road at Cottage Bridge at OS map ref SH 919562 and then generally north-eastwards along the A543 road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 929568.

(3) From the B4391 road at OS map ref SJ 017306 generally south-eastwards along the B4391 road to its junction with the B4393 road at Abertridwr; south-westwards along the B4393 road to its junction with the unclassified road crossing Afon Efyrynwy, along the unclassified road to the bridge over Afon Efyrynwy and then following the course of Afon Efyrynwy generally south-westwards to the confluence with Afon Conwy, north-eastwards along the course of the Afon Conwy, to the Forestry Commission fence at a point at OS map ref SH 999179 and then generally in a north-eastwards direction following the Forestry Boundary to its junction with the farm fence at OS map ref SH 995188 then generally northwards following the farm fence to OS map ref SH 998199 and then generally north-westwards along the Forestry fence to where it crosses the stream at OS map ref SH 989204 and then generally following the course of the stream to where it joins Llyn Efyrynwy near the waterfall at OS map ref SH 995206 and then crossing Llyn Efyrynwy in a generally north-westwards direction to the Forestry Boundary at OS map ref SH 988217 and then following the Forestry Boundary to its junction with the stream at OS map ref SH 993225 and then generally eastwards following the course of the stream through the forestry to its junction with the stream at OS map ref SH 999222 and then generally north-eastwards following the course of the stream to where it meets the Forestry Boundary at OS map ref SJ 000224 and then generally north-eastwards following the Forestry Boundary to where it joins the fenced Nant Coedwyr Boundary at OS map ref SJ 003226 and then generally north-eastwards, following the fenced Nant Coedwyr Boundary to where it joins the Severn-Trent Boundary at OS map ref SJ 013240 and then generally north-westwards along the Severn-Trent Boundary passing through OS map refer-

ences SJ 004244 and SJ 003260 to where it joins the fence at the County Boundary at OS map ref SH 990280 at Cynriau Nod and then generally north-eastwards following the fence along the County Boundary Sheepwalks of Blaencwm and Blaenrhiwarth at OS map ref SJ 003308 and then generally eastwards along the fences on the Northern Side of the Sheepwalks to their junction with the B4391 at OS map ref SJ 017306.

The area excludes any part of a road, footpath, river or body of water by reference to which its boundary is defined.

Area excepted from restrictions on 5th September 1986

2. An area comprising those parts of the designated area which lie within the following boundaries:—

(1) From the junction of the unmarked road with the unmarked road leading to Bryn Hall to the north of Llanllechid at OS map ref SH 621690 generally northwards along the unmarked road through Crymlyn to the junction with the A55(T) road at Aber; eastwards along the A55(T) road to the point where it crosses the river at OS map ref SH 656728, following the course of the river to the coast and then generally north-eastwards along the coast to the Castle at Conwy; from the Castle at Conwy generally westwards along the A55(T) road to its junction with the road known as Mount Pleasant; generally south-westwards along Mount Pleasant, St. Agnes Road and Hendre Road through Hendre to Groesffordd; generally south-westwards along the unmarked road from Groesffordd to the junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 761752; generally south-eastwards along that unmarked road to the junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 767746, generally southwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 768732; generally south-westwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the unmarked road west of Roewen at OS map ref SH 755721; eastwards along the unmarked road to Roewen and then generally south-westwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 737709 generally westwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the boundary wall at OS map ref SH 721716; generally south-eastwards along the boundary wall to OS map ref SH 728704 then generally north-westwards along the boundary wall to OS map ref SH 709714; generally north-eastwards along the boundary wall passing through OS map refs SH 716722, SH 739728, SH 749738, SH 745737, SH 747751, SH 753761, SH 761761, SH 762771 and SH 749772 to its junction with the railway line at OS Map ref SH 775779; generally westwards along the railway line to where it meets the boundary wall at OS map ref SH 744784 on the western side of Penmaen-bach Point; generally southwards along the boundary wall to where it meets the boundary fence at OS map ref SH 747769, generally south-westwards following the boundary fence passing through OS map refs SH 730746, SH 728757, SH 703751, SH 703742, SH 711738, SH 700721, SH 693726, SH 693738, SH 683738, SH 689726, SH 680704, SH 660701, SH 656716, SH 636702, and SH 639696 to where it joins the unmarked road near Bryn Hall at OS map ref SH 633693; generally westwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the unmarked road to the north of Llanllechid at OS map ref SH 621690.

(2) From where the disused tramway meets the A4085 road at OS map ref SH 532582 generally north-westwards along the A4085 road to the junction with the unmarked road south of Croesywaun and generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the A4086 road east of Llanrug; south-eastwards along the A4086 road to the junction with the B4547 road and generally northwards along the B4547 road to the junction with the unmarked

road north of Brynrefail at OS map ref SH 559629; generally southwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 559624 generally eastwards along the unmarked road to where it meets the Llanberis Lake Railway at Pen Llyn at OS map ref SH 562622; following the line of the Llanberis Lake Railway to Gilfach Ddu station; generally southwards along the unmarked road to OS map ref SH 587601 then westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the A4086 road at OS map ref SH 583598; generally north-westwards along the A4086 road to its junction with Llanberis High Street at OS map ref SH 582599; generally north-westwards along Llanberis High Street to its junction with Stryd Ceunant at OS map ref SH 578601; generally south-westwards along Stryd Ceunant becoming an unmarked road to where it meets a fence at OS map ref SH 574595; generally north-westwards following the fence to OS map ref SH 573596; generally southwards to OS map ref SH 572594; generally south-westwards through OS map references SH 572593, SH 570591, SH 569590, SH 568588, SH 566587 to OS map ref SH 556577; generally north-westwards to OS map ref SH 554578; generally westwards to OS map ref SH 548579; generally south-westwards to a disused mine at OS map ref SH 544578; generally south-westwards to OS map ref SH 593577; generally north-westwards along the old Waenfawr/Nant Y Betws Parish Boundary to OS map ref SH 535579 where it meets the East Bank of the Afon Gwyrfai; following the East Bank of the Afon Gwyrfai northwards to where the disused tramway crosses the Afon Gwyrfai at OS map ref SH 534583; southwestwards along the line of the disused tramway over the Afon Gwyrfai to where it meets the A487 road at OS map ref SH 532582.

(3) From a point at the Forestry Commission boundary fence at OS map ref SH 932166 near Drum Ddu generally southwards following the fence along the County Boundary to a stream at a point at OS map ref SH 921151 and then following the course of the stream southwards along Hen Bwll to the A458(T) road at Nant-y-Dugoed, generally westwards along the A458(T) road to the junction with the A470(T) road at Mallwyd and north-westwards along the A470(T) road to the junction with the B4416 road; generally north-eastwards along the B4416 road to the junction with the unmarked road at Brithdir; generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road to where it meets the forestry fence at OS map ref SH 788194; generally south-eastwards following the fence around Coed Helygog to OS map ref SH 795185 where it joins the stone wall; generally south-eastwards following the stone wall to OS map ref SH 800181 where it joins a fence then generally east and north-eastwards along the fence that follows the Parish boundary passing by Bwlch y Fign at OS map ref SH 822187, by Glasgwm at OS map ref SH 845196, by Drws Bach at OS map ref SH 862213, turning eastwards near Creiglyn Dyfiant at OS map ref SH 865230 continuing generally eastwards passing by Bwlch Sirddyn at OS map ref SH 887228 until it meets the County Boundary at Bwlch Groes at OS map ref SH 916229, generally southwards along the fence that follows the County Boundary to the Severn-Trent Water Authority fence at OS map ref SH 928202 and thereafter as a Forestry Commission fence to a point near Drum Ddu at OS map reference SH 932166.

(4) From the junction of the unmarked roads near Bryn Sylldy at OS map ref SH 823619 generally northwards along the unmarked road through Henblas and Henffrith to the junction with the A548 road at OS map ref SH 828638 and north-eastwards along the A548 road to its junction with the B5113 road at Farm Yard and then southwards along the B5113 road to its junction with the unmarked road southwest of Gors Wen at OS map ref SH 846619 and then generally westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Bryn Sylldy at OS map ref SH 823619.

(5) From the junction of the B5384 road at Gwytherin with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 877616 generally northeastwards along the B5384 road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 906645; generally eastwards along the unmarked road to where it crosses Nant Melai at Bontgarreg; generally southwards following the course of Nant Melai to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 909619 then generally eastwards along the unmarked road through Tan-y-foel to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 917619; generally southwards along the unmarked road through Glan-y-gors and near the eastern side of the Aled Isaf Reservoir and the north eastern side of Llyn Aled to its junction with the A543 road at OS map ref SH 929568; generally south-westwards along the A543 road to Cottage Bridge at OS map ref SH 919562 then following the course of the Afon Alwen generally eastwards to the Alwen Reservoir along the north-eastern side of the Alwen Reservoir to where it meets the Afon Alwen; generally south-eastwards along the course of the Afon Alwen to its crossing with the B4501 road at OS map ref SH 963523; generally southwards along the B4501 road to the junction with the B5105 at Cerrigydrudion; generally south-westwards along the unmarked road crossing the A5(T) road to the junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 949485 generally westwards along the unmarked road passing by Bwlch y Mawn around the southern side of Moel Eglwys to its junction with the unmarked road near Pengwern at OS map ref SH 898474, generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road passing through Bryn, Garn Brys to its junction with the unmarked road near Rhydlydan at OS map ref SH 886509; generally westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Penlan at OS map ref SH 876511; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the A5(T) and B5113 roads at Pentrefoelas; generally north-westwards along the B5113 road passing through Maes Gwyn, Ty'n y Llidiart to the fence at the County Boundary at OS map ref SH 852538; then generally northwards along the fence following the County Boundary to Moel Seisiog at OS map ref SH 862573 generally eastwards along the fence till it meets the stream at OS map ref SH 881576; generally north-westwards along the stream and then along the Afon Cledwen to its crossing with the unmarked road near Tŷ-Drâw at OS map ref SH 870590; generally northwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Bryn-y-Clochydd at OS map ref SH 875607; generally northwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the B5384 road at Gwytherin.

The area excludes any part of a road, footpath, river or body of water by reference to which its boundary is defined.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986 (“the principal order”), as amended by the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Amendment Order 1986 and the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Amendment No. 2 Order 1986, contains emergency prohibitions restricting various activities in order to prevent human consumption of food which has been or which may have been rendered unsuitable for that purpose in consequence of the escape of radioactive substances from a nuclear reactor situated at Chernobyl in the USSR.

This order substitutes a new Schedule 2 to the principal order for the purpose of:—

- (a) excepting from the restrictions imposed by the principal order those sheep which were in that part of the designated area described in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 on 5th September 1986; in consequence any sheep which have been moved from that area before that date remain subject to the restrictions imposed by the principal order and, in particular, may not be slaughtered, anywhere in the United Kingdom, for human consumption or for use in the preparation of feeding stuffs;
- (b) remedying two minor clerical errors in the first line of paragraph 1(1) of the previous Schedule 2.

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
