CONTAMINATION OF FOOD

The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (No. 8) Partial Revocation (No. 2) Order 1986

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1(1) and 24(3) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985^(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This order shall be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (No. 8) Partial Revocation (No. 2) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 4th October 1986.

Interpretation

2. In this order "the principal order" means the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (No. 8) Order 1986^(b) and "designated areas" means those areas described in Schedule 1 to the principal order.

Revocation

3. The principal order is revoked in its application to those parts of the designated areas described as follows:-

Dumfries and Galloway

- (a) The area of land within the Parish of Kirkgunzeon bounded on the west by the Parish boundary running northwards from Kirkgunzeon Lane viaduct along the Kirkgunzeon Lane until near the bridge at Newfield, on the north running generally in a north easterly direction by the Kirkgunzeon Lane and ditch until its junction with the course of the old railway on the east and south east running in a south westerly direction by the course of the old railway until it meets the Parish boundary at Kirkgunzeon Lane viaduct.

- (b) The area of land within the Parish of Kirkgunzeon bounded on the north west by the fence from Bargrug Cottage to Bargrug Plantation by Bargrug Plantation and on the north and the north east by the fence running generally in an easterly direction from Bargrug Plantation to the point national grid reference NX875631 and thence to the point national grid reference NX877637 and from there running easterly to the Plascow Rig Plantation on the east and south east by the Plascow Rig Plantation until it meets the unclassified road from Congeith to Auchenskeoch Lodge, on the south west by the unclassified road running in a north westerly direction until Bargrug Cottage.
- (c) The area of land within the Parish of New Abbey bounded on the west by Loch Arthur on the north and east by Loch Arthur Plantations on the south east by the fence from Loch Arthur Plantation running south westerly until it meets the Glensone Hill Plantation and on the south by the Glensone Hill Plantation and the southern section of the Loch Arthur Plantations until it meets the eastern side of Loch Arthur.
- (d) The area of land within the Parish of New Abbey bounded on the north by the Glensone Burn running in an easterly direction until it meets the weir below the junction of the Glensone Burn and the Kinharvie Burn, on the east by the Kinharvie Plantation and the Kinharvie Burn running in a southerly direction until Hawkhill, on the south by Hayfield Knowe part of the Kinharvie Plantation in a westerly direction until the Cullendeugh Plantation and on the west running in a north westerly direction by the Cullendeugh Plantation and the Drungons Plantation until the said Plantation meets the Glensone Burn.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order partially revokes for the second time the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (No. 8) Order 1986, as amended, which designated areas in Scotland and imposed prohibitions and restrictions on various activities in those areas in order to prevent the human consumption of food rendered unsuitable for that purpose in consequence of the escape of radioactive substances from a nuclear reactor situated at Chernobyl in the Ukraine, USSR.

This order removes completely the prohibitions and restrictions on the slaughter and movement of sheep in other parts of the designated areas. These parts are 2 areas of land within the Parish of Kirkgunzeon and 2 areas of land within the Parish of New Abbey.
