The Data Protection (Fees) Regulations 1986

Made - - - - - 6th November 1986
Laid before Parliament 17th November 1986
Coming into Operation 15th December 1986

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 9(2) and 40 of the Data Protection Act 1984(a), and after consultation with the Data Protection Registrar and with the approval of the Treasury, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (Fees) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 15th December 1986.
- 2. The fee payable by a member of the public for the supply, by the Data Protection Registrar, under section 9(2) of the Data Protection Act 1984, of a written copy of the particulars contained in any entry made in the register maintained under section 4 of that Act shall be £2 in respect of each entry of which a copy is supplied.
