POLICE**The Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1986**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 35 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing the said Board with a draft of the Regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1986.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 31st December 1986 and shall have effect for the purposes of Regulation 4 as from 1st September 1986.

3. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets Regulations 1979(c).

4. For the Table in Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following Table:—

“TABLE

Age	London	Provinces
Under 17 years	£3,546 a year	£3,015 a year
17 years	£3,726 a year	£3,195 a year
18 years or over	£4,089 a year	£3,558 a year”

5. For paragraph 2 of Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations (charge for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“2. The annual rate of charge shall be—

(a) in the case of a police cadet attached to the City of London or Metropolitan Police force, £453;

(b) in any other case, £420.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets Regulations 1979 with effect, as provided by Regulation 2, from the dates mentioned below.

Regulation 4 increases the pay of cadets from 1st September 1986 (retrospective effect is authorised by section 33(4), as applied by section 35(2), of the Police Act 1964). Regulation 5 increases from 31st December 1986 charges payable by cadets for board and lodging provided by police authorities.
