**The Strathkelvin District and Bearsden and Milngavie
District (Dougalston) Boundaries Amendment
Order 1986**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) to give effect to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland under section 14(2) of the Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Strathkelvin District and Bearsden and Milngavie District (Dougalston) Boundaries Amendment Order 1986, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1986.

Interpretation

2. In the Schedule to this order—

- (a) any reference to a boundary of a district is a reference to a boundary existing immediately before the commencement of this order; and
- (b) any reference to a burn shall be construed as a reference to the centre line of that burn.

Application of regulations

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(b) shall apply for the purpose of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area changes effected by article 4 of this order.

Area changes

4. Those parts of Strathkelvin District containing areas at Dougalston, being Areas A and B described in the Schedule to this order and delineated, hatched and marked "Area A" and "Area B" respectively on the map signed as relative to this order, shall be transferred to Bearsden and Milngavie District.

Consequential changes of electoral arrangements

5. Areas A and B described in the Schedule to this order (being the areas transferred by article 4 of this order)—

(a) shall cease to form part of Electoral Division 47 (Bishopbriggs) of Strathclyde Region (a) and of District Ward 6 (Kenmure and Baldernock) of Strathkelvin District (b); and

(b) shall form part of Electoral Division 44 (Milngavie/Kilmardinny) of Strathclyde Region and of District Ward 1 (Barloch) of Bearsden and Milngavie District (c).

SCHEDULE

Articles 4 and 5

AREA A

Commencing on the western boundary of Strathkelvin District at the point opposite the northernmost point of Deer Park; then southeastward in a straight line to the said point and continuing southeastward, southward and southeastward along the northern and eastern boundaries of Deer Park to and southwestward along, an unnamed burn to the western boundary of Strathkelvin District; then northwestward and northeastward along the said District boundary to the point of commencement.

AREA B

Commencing on the western boundary of Strathkelvin District at the point where it meets the western side of Dowan Road; then southward along the western side of the said road to and southwestward and southeastward by field boundaries forming the eastern boundary of Beech Wood to the western boundary of Parcel number 8065, as shown on 1:2500 microfilm (A) NS 5673 date of publication 1968; then southeastward along the said boundary and the western boundaries of Parcels number 8547 and 953 to the northern side of the A807 road; then generally northwestward along the north side of the said road to and northwestward, northeastward and northward along the western boundary of Strathkelvin District to the point of commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order transfers areas of approximately 11.6 acres and 44.4 acres at Dougalston from Strathkelvin District to Bearsden and Milngavie District and makes consequential changes of electoral arrangements.

The areas transferred are shown on the map which forms part of this Note.

Copies of the map referred to in article 4 of this order may be inspected at the offices of any of the local authorities referred to in this order.
