FOREIGN COMPENSATION

The Foreign Compensation (Financial Provisions) Order 1986

<i>Made - - - -</i>	12th February 1986
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	20th February 1986
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	20th March 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 12th day of February 1986

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her in that behalf by section 7(2) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1950(a) and section 3(3) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1962(b) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreign Compensation (Financial Provisions) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 20th March 1986.

2. The Foreign Compensation Commission shall pay into the Consolidated Fund not later than 31st March 1986 out of the compensation fund named in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order the amount specified in Column 2 of the Schedule which is hereby determined to be the amount of the expenses of the Commission during the period 1st October 1984 to 30th September 1985 attributable to the discharge by the Commission of their functions in relation to the distribution of sums from that compensation fund.
