**The Northern Ireland Assembly (Allowances) (Variation) Order
1986***Made* - - - - - 12th February 1986*Coming into Operation* 12th February 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 12th day of February 1986

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 26(2), (2A) and (6) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:-

1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Assembly (Allowances) (Variation) Order 1986.

(2) This Order shall come into operation forthwith and shall have effect as provided below.

2.— (1) For paragraphs (i) and (ii) of sub-paragraph (c) (travelling allowance in the case of a journey by a motor vehicle other than an omnibus or motor cycle) of Article 4(1) of the Northern Ireland Assembly (Pay and Allowances) Order 1984(b), there shall be substituted the following:—

“as respects any financial year beginning on or after 1st April 1985, 30.4p for every mile of that journey not exceeding a total distance of 10,000 miles travelled in that year and 18p for every mile exceeding that distance travelled in that year by the member in question;”.

(2) For sub-paragraph (d) (travelling allowance in the case of a journey by motor cycle) of Article 4(1) of that Order, there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(d) in the case of a journey on or after 1st April 1985 by motor cycle—

(a) 1973 c.36; section 26(2A) was inserted by paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 2 to the Northern Ireland Act 1982 (c.38).

(b) S.I. 1984/1823.

- (i) the engine capacity of which does not exceed 150 c.c., 8p for every mile of that journey;
 - (ii) the engine capacity of which exceeds 150 c.c. and does not exceed 250 c.c., 12p for every mile of that journey; or
 - (iii) the engine capacity of which exceeds 250 c.c., 16p for every mile of that journey;”.
- (3) Paragraph (4) of Article 4 of that Order shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Northern Ireland Assembly (Pay and Allowances) Order 1984 (“the 1984 Order”) by increasing the allowance payable to a member of the Northern Ireland Assembly to defray expenses incurred by him on travelling in Northern Ireland by either a motor vehicle (other than an omnibus or motor cycle) or a motor cycle in carrying out his duties as a member. This Order also amends the 1984 Order by omitting spent provisions about allowances in respect of travelling by such a motor vehicle for the period between 1st October 1984 and 31st March 1985.

To the extent that the increases have retrospective effect, they are authorised by section 26(2A) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973.
