FEES AND CHARGES

The Measuring Instruments (EEC Pattern Approval Requirements) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1986*Made* - - - 8th May 1986*Laid before Parliament* 16th May 1986*Coming into Operation* 9th June 1986

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Measuring Instruments (EEC Pattern Approval Requirements) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 9th June 1986.

2. The Measuring Instruments (EEC Pattern Approval Requirements) (Fees) (No. 2) Regulations 1981(b) are hereby amended in paragraph 1(1)(a) of the Schedule by omitting the figures “£27.50”, “£21.65” and “£3.60” and substituting therefor respectively the figures “£30.80”, “£24.20” and “£4.00”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Measuring Instruments (EEC Pattern Approval Requirements) (Fees) (No. 2) Regulations 1981. They increase the fees for examiner staff time (from £27.50 to £30.80 per hour), equipment test unit staff time (from £21.65 to £24.20 per hour) and use of an environmental testing chamber (from £3.60 to £4.00 per hour).
