MERCHANT SHIPPING

**The Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment No. 1)
Regulations 1986***Made* - - - - - 8th May 1986*Laid before Parliament* 14th May 1986*Coming into Operation* 5th June 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 33(2) of the Merchant Shipping (Safety Convention) Act 1949^(a) and now vested in him^(b) and section 21(1) and (3)(r) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979^(c) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment No. 1) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 5th June 1986.

2. The Schedule to the Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1985^(d) shall be further amended as follows:—

(a) in Part I, in the Table, the entry “H (Medical Scales)” shall be replaced by the following:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1985.

They provide for the increase of fees in connection with the registration of ships and copies of documents by between approximately 11% and 25%. They also update a reference to a statutory instrument in respect of which fees are charged.
