**The Northern Ireland Act 1974
(Interim Period Extension) Order 1987**

Made - - - - *11th July 1987*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:
Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(4) of the Northern Ireland Act 1974⁽¹⁾, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Act 1974 (Interim Period Extension) Order 1987 and shall come into force forthwith.

2. The interim period specified by section 1(4) of the Northern Ireland Act 1974 shall continue until 16th July 1988.
