**The Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1987
(Commencement No. 2) Order 1987**

Made - - - - 7th September 1987

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 72(2) of the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1987⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1.** This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1987 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1987.
- 2.** The provisions of the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1987 referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters described in Column 2 of that Schedule) shall come into force on 1st October 1987.
