## The Traffic Signs General (Amendment) Directions 1987

- **1.** These Directions may be cited as the Traffic Signs General (Amendment) Directions 1987 and shall come into force on 15th October 1987.
- **2.** The Traffic Signs General Directions 1981(1) shall be further amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Directions.
- **3.** In the directions specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these Directions, for the words specified in column (2) there shall be substituted the words specified in column (3).
  - **4.** In direction 36, after paragraph (3) there shall be inserted the following new paragraph—
    - "(4) The front of any backing board for a sign mounted otherwise than as described in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) shall be coloured either grey or yellow."
  - **5.** In direction 41, after paragraph (3) there shall be inserted the following new paragraph—
    - "(4) When a traffic sign to which this paragraph applies is not in use, it shall display a plain grey or black face.".
