GENERAL

[F1Disapplication of section 1(1A) of the Administration Act

- **2A.** Section 1(1A) of the Administration Act (requirement to state national insurance number) shall not apply—
 - (a) [F2 to a child or young person in respect of whom income support is claimed;]
 - (b) to a partner in respect of whom a claim for income support is made or treated as made before [F35th October 1998].]
 - [F4(c) to a person who—
 - (i) is a person in respect of whom a claim for income support is made;
 - (ii) is subject to immigration control within the meaning of section 115(9)(a) of the Immigration and Asylum Act;
 - (iii) is not entitled to any income support for the purposes of section 124 of the Contributions and Benefits Act; and
 - (iv) has not previously been allocated a national insurance number.]
