Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Disabled Persons (Services, Consultation and Representation) Act 1986 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1987.

(2) This Order shall not apply to Scotland.

(3) In this Order "the Act" means the Disabled Persons (Services, Consultation and Representation) Act 1986.
