RATING AND VALUATION

**The Valuation Timetable (Scotland)
Amendment (No. 2) Order 1987**

Made - - - - *30th April 1987*
Coming into force - - *8th May 1987*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 13(1) and 42(1) of the Valuation and Rating (Scotland) Act 1956⁽¹⁾, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Valuation Timetable (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Order 1987 and shall come into force on 8th May 1987.

2. The entry in column 2 of the Schedule to the Valuation Timetable (Scotland) Order 1984⁽²⁾ relating to the date for making valuations (in respect of the prevailing level of rents) mentioned in column 1 of that Schedule shall be amended by substituting for the words “1st July” the words “1st April”.
