**The Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles)  
(Exemption) (Revocation) Regulations 1987**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 96(10) of the Transport Act 1968<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 101(6) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles) (Exemption) (Revocation) Regulations 1987 and shall come into force on 2nd February 1987.

**2.** —The Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles) (Exemption) Regulations 1987<sup>(3)</sup> are hereby revoked.
