**The Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1988**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 29(1) and 198(2) of the Licensing Act 1964<sup>(1)</sup>, I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 1st August 1988.

2. The Schedule to the Licensing (Fees) Order 1978<sup>(2)</sup> shall be amended by inserting after the entry relating to the grant of a special order of exemption the following entries —

“Grant of order varying permitted hours in on-licensed vineyard premises — s.87A<sup>(3)</sup> 6.50

Variation or revocation of order varying permitted hours in on-licensed vineyard premises on application by holder of licence — s.87A(7) 6.50”.
