**The Blood Tests (Evidence of Paternity)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1988**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 22 of the Family Law Reform Act 1969<sup>(1)</sup>, I hereby make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Blood Tests (Evidence of Paternity) (Amendment) Regulations 1988 and shall come into force on 15th August 1988.
2. For Schedule 2 to the Blood Tests (Evidence of Paternity) Regulations 1971<sup>(2)</sup> there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
3. The Blood Tests (Evidence of Paternity) (Amendment) Regulations 1987<sup>(3)</sup> are hereby revoked.

## CHARGES MADE BY SAMPLERS AND TESTERS

## PART I

## Samplers

The charges which may be made by a sampler in respect of one direction requesting him to take samples shall be as follows:

[The previous charge is shown in brackets] £		
For making all necessary arrangements (whether or not samples are taken)	12.60	[11.60]
For making further arrangements (whether or not samples are taken) to give effect to a variation by the court of a direction	12.60	[11.60]
For taking sample —		
from first subject	12.60	[11.60]
from each subject after first	6.30	[5.80]
For taking second or subsequent samples from one or more subject —		
if one such sample	12.60	[11.60]
if two such samples	18.90	[17.60]
if three or more such samples	31.50	[29.20]

## PART II

## Testers

The charges which may be made by a tester in respect of tests for the purpose of giving effect to one direction shall be as follows:

For making a report in accordance with the direction and testing four or less samples	170.80	[158.00]
For testing each sample after the fourth covered by a report	34.20	[31.60]

£		
For testing samples where no report is made —		
in respect of the first sample	68.40	[63.20]
in respect of each subsequent sample	34.20	[31.60]”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations increase the charges which may be made under the Blood Tests (Evidence of Paternity) Regulations 1971 in respect of blood tests carried out for the purpose of determining paternity in civil proceedings. These were last increased in August 1987 (S.I.[1987/1199](#)).
