**The South West Water Authority  
(River Wolf Discharge) Order 1988**

*Made* - - - - *19th January 1988*

*Coming into force* - - *20th January 1988*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, on the application of the South West Water Authority, and in exercise of powers conferred on him by sections 1 and 2(3)(1) of the Water Resources Act 1971(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the South West Water Authority (River Wolf Discharge) Order 1988, and shall come into force on the 20th January 1988.

**2.** The South West Water Authority may for the purpose of augmenting the flow of the River Wolf discharge water from the Roadford Reservoir into the River Wolf at a discharge point at National Grid Reference SX 419899 at a rate not exceeding 1,000,000 cubic metres per day.
