**PLANT HEALTH**

**The Restriction on Movement of  
Spruce Wood (Amendment) Order 1988**

The Forestry Commissioners, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 3(1), (2) and (4) of the Plant Health Act 1967<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Restriction on Movement of Spruce Wood (Amendment) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 28th June 1988.

**Amendment of the Restriction on Movement of Spruce Wood Order 1982**

**2.** The Restriction on Movement of Spruce Wood Order 1982<sup>(2)</sup> shall be further amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto (areas in respect of which the movement of spruce wood is restricted) the following Schedule—

(1) 1967 c. 8; section 3(1) and (2) was amended by the European Communities Act 1972 (c. 68), section 4(1) and Schedule 4, paragraph 8(1) and (3); section 3(4) was substituted by the Criminal Justice Act 1982 (c. 48), section 42. The powers conferred by section 3 of the Plant Health Act 1967 are conferred on “a competent authority”, which expression is defined in section 1(2), as regards the protection of forest trees and timber from attack by pests, as the Forestry Commissioners.

MOVEMENT OF SPRUCE WOOD IS RESTRICTED

Avon	That part of the county which lies to the north of the southern boundary of the M4.
Cheshire	That part of the county which lies to the west of the eastern boundary of the M6.
Clwyd	} The whole county.

Greater Manchester	That part of the county which comprises the district of Wigan.
Gwent	} The whole county.
Gwynedd	
Hereford and Worcester	
Lancashire	
Merseyside	
Mid Glamorgan	
North Yorkshire	That part of the county which comprises the district of Craven.
Powys	} The whole county.
Shropshire	
South Glamorgan	
Staffordshire	That part of the county which comprises the districts of Cannock Chase, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Stafford, Stoke-on-Trent and South Staffordshire.
West Glamorgan	The whole county.
West Midlands	That part of the county which comprises the districts of Birmingham, Dudley, Sandwell, Walsall and Wolverhampton.”

## **Revocation**

**3.** The Restriction on Movement of Spruce Wood (Amendment) Order 1986**(3)** is hereby revoked.
