**The Visiting Forces and International Headquarters
(Application of Law) (Amendment) Order 1989**

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 2nd day of August 1989

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has in accordance with section 8(6) of the Visiting Forces Act 1952⁽¹⁾ been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of the said section 8, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Visiting Forces and International Headquarters (Application of Law) (Amendment) Order 1989, and shall come into force forthwith.

2. In article 3 (3) of the Visiting Forces and International Headquarters (Application of Law) Order 1965⁽²⁾ (which applies that Order to the visiting forces mentioned therein) for "Italy and the Federal Republic of Germany" there shall be substituted "Italy, the Federal Republic of Germany and Spain".
