**PART II**

**REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE FITTING OF LAMPS,  
REFLECTORS, REAR MARKINGS AND DEVICES**

**Restrictions on fitting blue warning beacons, special warning lamps and similar devices**

**16.** No vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle [<sup>F1</sup>or a vehicle used for special forces purposes], shall be fitted with—

- (a) a blue warning beacon or special warning lamp, or
- (b) a device which resembles a blue warning beacon or a special warning lamp, whether the same is in working order or not.
