## The Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1989

In pursuance of sections $18(1)(\mathrm{e})$ and $24(2)$ of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1989 and shall come into force on 1st April 1989.
2. The fee payable to the Board on an application for the registration of a scheme shall be-
(a) where the total value of the tickets or chances which may lawfully be sold in each lottery under the scheme does not exceed $£ 10,000$, a fee of $£ 100$; and
(b) in any other case, a fee of $£ 350$.
3. The further fee payable to the Board, where more than one lottery is to be promoted under a scheme registered by the Board, for each lottery promoted under that scheme shall be-
(a) where the total value of the tickets or chances sold in the lottery does not exceed $£ 10,000$, a fee of $£ 30$;
(b) where the total value of the tickets or chances sold in the lottery exceeds $£ 10,000$ but does not exceed $£ 20,000$, a fee of $£ 60$; and
(c) in any other case, a fee of $£ 75$.
4. The Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1988(b) is hereby revoked.
