**The Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary
Provisions)(Designated Ports) Order 1990**

Made - - - - 31st July 1990

Coming into force - - 3rd September 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 16(3) of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1989(1), I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) (Designated Ports) Order 1990 and shall come into force on 3rd September 1990.

2. In Part I of Schedule 6 to the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1989, there shall be omitted, under the heading “Seaports”, the word “Southampton”.
