ELECTRICITY

The Electricity (Register) Order 1990

Made - - - - *8th February 1990*

Laid before Parliament *12th February 1990*

Coming into force - - *31st March 1990*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 49(5) and (6) of the Electricity Act 1989 (1) and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Register) Order 1990 and shall come into force on 31st March 1990.
2. In this Order “the register” means the register maintained by the Director pursuant to section 49 of the Electricity Act 1989.
3. The contents of the register shall be available for inspection by the public between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on each working day.
4. The fee for the supply of a copy of, or extract from, any part of the register certified by the Director to be a true copy or extract shall be £2.00 together with 10p for each page supplied.
