**The Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988
(Commencement No. 3) Order 1990**

Made - - - - 20th December 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27(3) of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988⁽¹⁾, I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1990.

2. Section 20 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988 (removal of arms and ammunition to Northern Ireland) shall, insofar as it is not already in force, come into force on 2nd April 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
