## Arrangements for Placement of Children (General) Regulations 1991

## Retention and confidentiality of records

**9.**—(1) A case record relating to a child who is placed shall be retained by the responsible authority until the seventy-fifth anniversary of the date of birth of the child to whom it relates or, if the child diesbefore attaining the age of 18, for a period of 15 years beginning with the date of his death.

(2) The requirements of paragraph (1) may be complied with either byretaining the original written record, or a copy of it, or by keepingall of the information from such record in some other accessible form(such as by means of a computer).

(3) A responsible authority shall secure the safe keeping of caserecords and shall take all necessary steps to ensure that informationcontained in them is treated as confidential, subject onlyto—

- (a) any provision of or made under or by virtue of, a statute underwhich access to such records or information may be obtained or given;
- (b) any court order under which access to such records or informationmay be obtained or given.
