DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

Employment to which section 50 of the Act applies

11. For the purposes of section 50 of the Act (unauthorised disclosure of information) the following kinds of employment are prescribed in addition to those specified in paragraphs (a) to (e) of section 50(5)—

- (a) the Comptroller and Auditor General;
- (b) the Parliamentary Commissioner for Administration;
- (c) the Health Service Commissioner for England;
- - (e) [^{F2}the Scottish Public Services Ombudsman];
 - (f) any member of the staff of the National Audit Office;
 - (g) any other person who carries out the administrative work of that Office, or who provides, or is employed in the provision of, services to it;
 - (h) any officer of any of the Commissioners [^{F3} or of the Ombudsman] referred to in paragraphs
 (b) to (e) above; ^{F4}...
 - (i) any person who provides, or is employed in the provision of, services to the Department of Social Security^{F5}; and
 - (j) the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales, a member of his or her staff, or another person acting on his or her behalf or assisting him or her in the discharge of any of his or her functions.]
