## The Food Safety (Amendment) (Metrication) Regulations 1992

## **Amendment of Margarine Regulations**

- **8.** The Margarine Regulations 1967(1) and the Margarine (Scotland) Regulations 1970(2) shall be amended by substituting—
  - (a) for the definition of "vitamin A" in regulation 2(1) of each of those Regulations the following definition—
    - ""vitamin A" means vitamin A present as such or as its esters and includes betacarotene on the basis that 6 micrograms of beta-carotene or 12 micrograms of other biologically active carotenoids equal 1 microgram of retinol equivalent.";
  - (b) for regulation 6(1) in each of those Regulations the following provision—
    - "(1) Any margarine sold by retail shall contain in every 100 grams of such margarine—
      - (a) not less than 800 micrograms and not more than 1000 micrograms of vitamin A (retinol equivalent), and
    - (b) not less than 7.05 micrograms and not more than 8.82 micrograms of vitamin D, and a proportionate amount in any part of 100 grams.".
