Collection and enforcement—England and Wales

3. In relation to England and Wales, sections 29(2) and (3) and 31 to [F140B] of the Act, and any regulations made under those sections, shall apply for the purpose of enabling the Secretary of State to enforce any obligation to pay any amount which he is authorised to collect under section 30 of the Act, with the modification that any reference in those sections or regulations to child support maintenance shall be read as a reference to any of the periodical payments mentioned in regulation 2 above, and any reference to a [F2maintenance calculation] shall be read as a reference to any of the maintenance orders mentioned in that regulation.
