## **BUILDING SOCIETIES**

The Building Societies (Limits on Lending) Order 1992

Made	23rd November 1992
Laid before Parliament	24th November 1992
Coming into force	15th December 1992

The Building Societies Commission, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 16(8) of the Building Societies Act 1986(1) hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Limits on Lending) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 15th December 1992.

### Specification of sums for the purposes of section 16(8) of the Building Societies Act 1986

**2.** The sum specified for the purposes of section 16(8) (limit on loans to any one individual) of the Building Societies Act 1986 shall be £25,000.

**3.** Paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Building Societies (Limits on Lending) Order 1988(**2**) is hereby repealed.
