**The Medicines Act 1968 (Amendment)
(No. 2) Regulations 1992**

Interpretation of the Act

3. In section 132(1) of the Act (interpretation)(1) after the definition of “dentist” there is inserted—

““the 1965 Directive” means Council Directive [65/65/EEC\(2\)](#) of 26th January 1965 on the approximation of provisions laid down by law, regulation or administrative action relating to medicinal products (as amended by Council Directive [89/341/EEC\(3\)](#) and as it applies in accordance with Council Directives [75/319/EEC\(4\)](#), [89/342/EEC\(5\)](#), [89/343/EEC\(6\)](#) and [89/381/EEC\(7\)](#));

“the 1981 Directive” means Council Directive [81/851/EEC\(8\)](#) of 28th September 1981 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to veterinary medicinal products (as amended by Council Directive [90/676/EEC\(9\)](#));”.
