

## SCHEDULE 1

### DEFINITION OF STUDENTS, ETC

#### PART IV

#### YOUTH TRAINING

**8.**—(1) A person is a youth training trainee on a particular day if, on that day, he is undertaking training pursuant to arrangements made under section 2 of the Employment and Training Act 1973<sup>(1)</sup> or section 2 of the Enterprise and New Towns (Scotland) Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup>, and in either case, these arrangements constitute an approved training scheme for the purposes of section 28 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992<sup>(3)</sup>.

(2) A person is to be regarded as undertaking training on a particular day for the purposes of paragraph (1) if the day falls within the relevant period for that course.
