

SCHEDULE 5

CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY

1. A certificate of registry for a ship registered or to be registered on Part I of the Register shall contain:—

- (a) the full name and address of the owner(s),
- (b) the number of shares owned by each owner and if any are jointly owned, with whom they are owned
- (c) the following information about the ship:—
 - (i) name,
 - [^{F1}(ii) either the IMO number or HIN number, as appropriate,]
 - (iii) radio call sign,
 - (iv) port of choice,
 - (v) official number,
 - (vi) year of build,
 - (vii) method of propulsion e.g. whether sail, steam, motor or dumb,
 - (viii) length-metric units,
 - (ix) breadth-metric units,
 - (x) depth-metric units,
 - (xi) type of ship e.g. dry cargo, oil tanker, passenger, bulk carrier,
 - [^{F2}(xii) such of the following tonnages as are specified in the certificate of survey; gross, net and registered,]
 - (xv) engine make and model,
 - (xvi) engine power in kilowatts,
- (d) the date of issue of the certificate,
- (e) the date the certificate expires.
