SCHEDULE 2

Articles 5, 6 and 7

SECTION 35(1), (1A) AND (3) OF THE 1968 ACT

PART I

35.—(1) Subject to this Act, on the registration of a person as a firearms dealer there shall be payable by him a fee of \pounds 118.

PART II

35.—(1A) If the chief officer of police for the area in which the applicant has applied to be registered is satisfied–

(a) that the only place of business in respect of which the application is made is at a game fair, trade fair or exhibition, agricultural show or an event of a similar character; and

(b) that the applicant's principal place of business is entered in the register for another area, the fee payable shall be $\pounds 12$.

PART III

35.—(3) Before a person for the time being registered as a firearms dealer can be granted a new certificate of registration under section 33(5) of this Act, he shall pay a fee of £50.
