PROCEDURE

The County Court (Amendment) Rules 1994

Made - - - - - *10th February 1994*

Coming into force - - - - - *7th March 1994*

1. These Rules may be cited as the County Court (Amendment) Rules 1994.
2. After Order 38, rule 3(2) of the County Court Rules 1981(1), there shall be inserted the following—

“(2A) Scales 1 and 2 shall not apply to determine the amount of costs to be allowed to the extent that regulations made under the Legal Aid Act 1988(2) determine the amount of costs payable to legal representatives in relation to proceedings to which this Order applies.”.
