ASCERTAINMENT

(1) <i>Subsidiary hazard</i>	(2) <i>Subsidiary hazard sign</i>
Liable to explosion	 A diamond-shaped sign with an orange background and a black border. It features a black silhouette of an explosion with radiating lines.
Danger of fire (flammable gas)	 A diamond-shaped sign with a red background and a black border. It features a black silhouette of a flame.
Danger of fire (flammable liquid)	 A diamond-shaped sign with a red background and a black border. It features a black silhouette of a flame.
Danger of fire (flammable solid)	 A diamond-shaped sign with a red background and a black border. It features a black silhouette of a flame. The sign is surrounded by a white border with red diagonal stripes.
