**The Longlands College of Further Education,  
Middlesbrough and Marton Sixth Form College  
Middlesbrough (Dissolution) Order 1995**

Whereas the Secretary of State for Education has received a proposal from the Further Education Funding Council for England, made in accordance with section 51 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992<sup>(1)</sup> (“the Act”), for the dissolution under section 27 of the Act of the further education corporations known as Longlands College of Further Education, Middlesbrough and Marton Sixth Form College, Middlesbrough<sup>(2)</sup> (“the Old Corporations”);

Now therefore in exercise of the power conferred on her by section 27 of the Act the Secretary of State after consulting the Old Corporations and with the consent of the further education corporation known as Teesside Tertiary College<sup>(3)</sup> (“the New Corporation”) hereby makes the following Order:
