The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on her by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Royal Hull Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995 and shall come into force on 26th January 1995.

**Amendment of NHS Trust Establishment Order**

2. In Article 4 of the Royal Hull Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1992<sup>(3)</sup> (directors of the trust) there shall be added at the end the words “, and, since the trust is to be regarded as having a significant teaching commitment within the meaning of paragraph 3(1)(d) of Schedule 2 to the Act, one of those non-executive directors shall be appointed from the University of Hull”.
