**The Food Labelling Regulations 1996**

**PART II**

**FOOD TO BE DELIVERED AS SUCH TO THE  
ULTIMATE CONSUMER OR TO CATERERS**

*Manner of marking or labelling*

**Field of vision**

**39.**—(1) Where a food is required to be marked or labelled with more than one of the following indications, such indications shall appear in the labelling of the food in the same field of vision—

- (a) the name of the food,
- (b) an appropriate durability indication,
- (c) an indication of alcoholic strength by volume,
- (d) the cautionary words in respect of raw milk,
- (e) the warning required on certain products by regulation 32, and
- (f) an indication of the net quantity as required by the Weights and Measures Act 1985<sup>(1)</sup> or by any Order or Regulations made thereunder.

(2) Paragraph (1)(b), (c) and (f) of this regulation shall not apply to any food sold in a bottle or packaging where such bottle or packaging is the subject of regulation 26.
