## The Education (Assisted Places) (Incidental Expenses) (Amendment) Regulations 1996

## Amendments to the principal expenses Regulations

- 3. In regulation 3—
  - (a) for paragraph (3) there is substituted—
    - "(3) The school shall pay uniform grant to the parents in the case of an assisted pupil—
      - (i) who is in his first year at a school as an assisted pupil, and
      - (ii) as regards whom the relevant income does not exceed £11,056,

of an amount equal to so much of the parents' clothing expenditure as does not exceed—

- (a) £169 where the relevant income does not exceed £9,707;
- (b) £127 where that income exceeds £9,707 but does not exceed £10,159;
- (c) £83 where that income exceeds £10,159 but does not exceed £10,593; and
- (d) £43 where that income exceeds £10,595 but does not exceed £11,056."; and
- (b) for paragraph (5), there is substituted—
  - "(5) Except where paragraph (3) applies, a school shall pay uniform grant in the case of an assisted pupil as regards whom the relevant income does not exceed £10,595 and in such case the grant shall be of an amount equal to so much of the clothing expenditure (disregarding expenditure in respect of which a previous grant has been paid) as does not exceed—
    - (a) £63 where the relevant income does not exceed £9,873; and
    - (b) £33 where that income exceeds £9,873 but does not exceed £10,595.".
