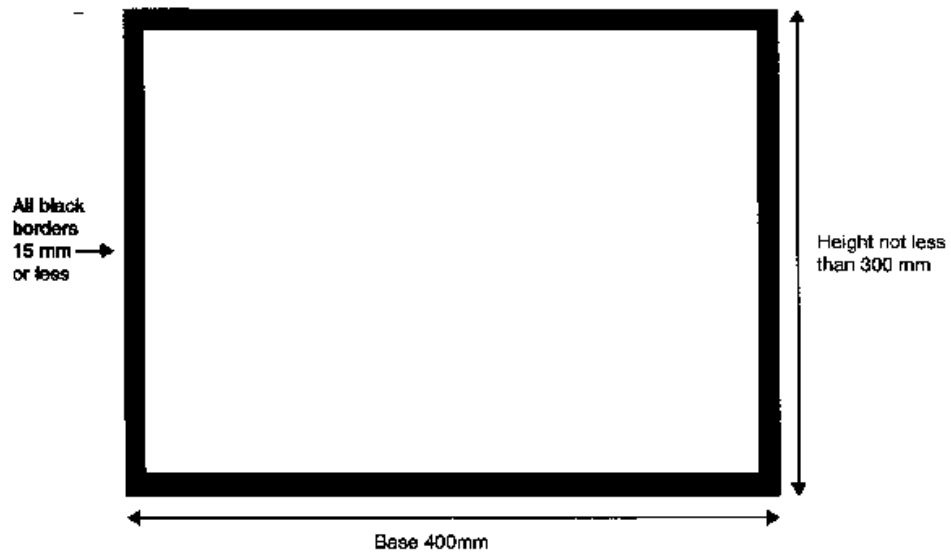
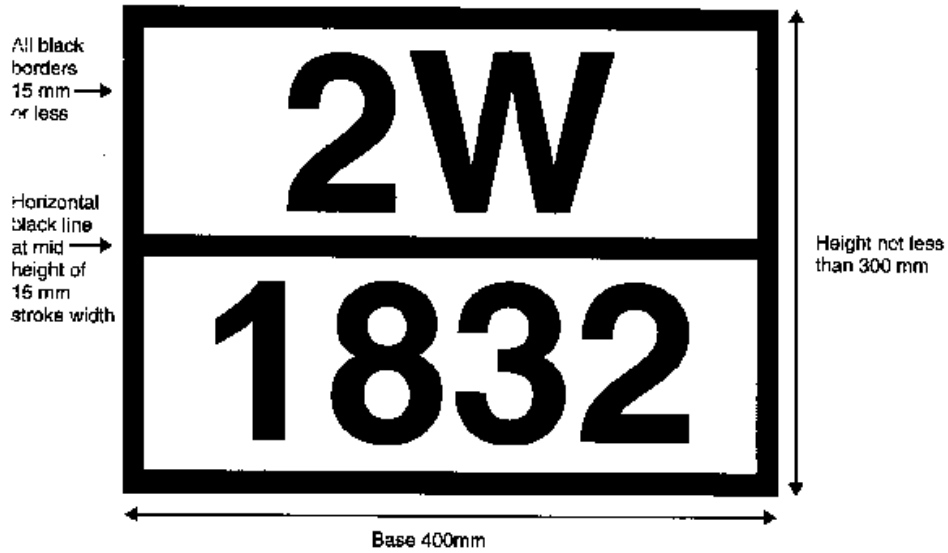

Orange-coloured panel displaying the emergency action code and the UN number



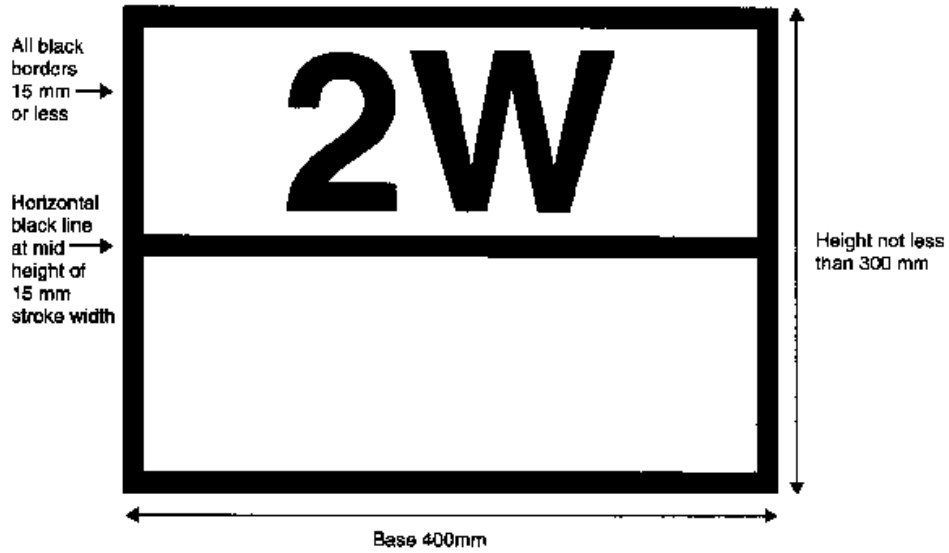

Orange-coloured panel displaying the UN number

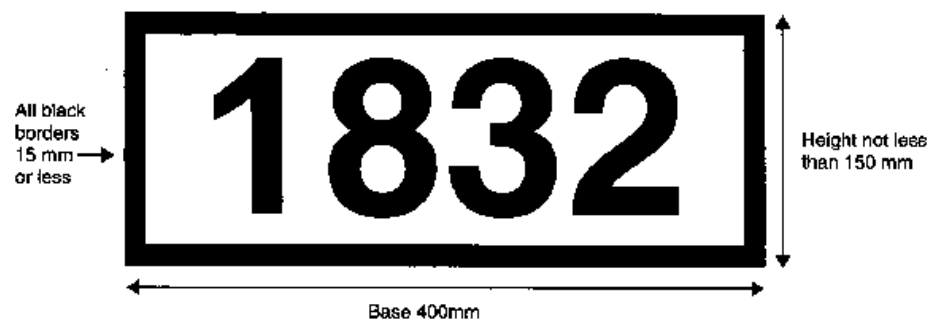
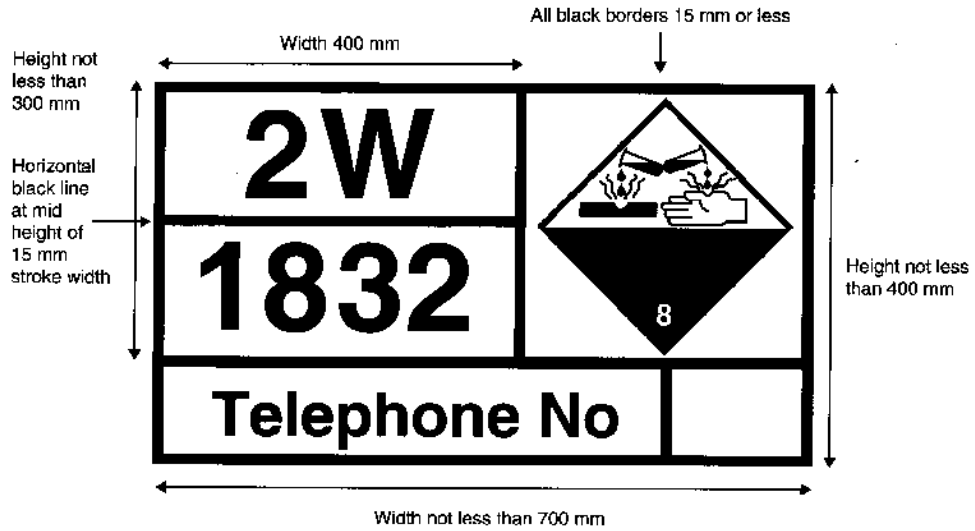
