The Social Security Benefit (Computation of Earnings) Regulations 1996

PART I GENERAL

Calculation of earnings

- **3.**—(1) For the purposes of Parts II to V (other than those of Schedule 8) of the Contributions and Benefits Act ^{MI} and of any regulations made thereunder which relate to benefit under those Parts of that Act or regulations, the earnings of a claimant shall be calculated by determining in accordance with these Regulations the weekly amount of his earnings.
- (2) The amount of a claimant's earnings for any period shall be the whole of those earnings (including any earnings which he is treated as possessing under regulation 4 (notional earnings)) except in so far as regulations 10 and 13 provide that certain sums shall be disregarded or deducted as appropriate.
