## The Local Government Changes for England (Miscellaneous Provision) Order 1996

## Electoral arrangements for parishes in the district of York

- **6.**—(1) The following provisions shall apply to the elections of the parish councils of the parishes of Rufforth, Hessay, Upper Poppleton and Nether Poppleton in the district of York(1).
- (2) Elections of all councillors of the councils of those parishes shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1996, 1999 and every fourth year after 1999(2).
- (3) The term of office of any councillor so elected shall be, in the case of the councillors elected in 1996, three years and, in any other case, four years.
  - (4) on the fourth day afterany such elections—
    - (a) the persons who were councillors immediately before those elections shall retire; and
    - (b) the newly elected councillors shall come into office.
